1.0 POLICY:

Appeal Procedure: Secondary student suspension for disciplinary reasons for ten (10) days or less. Appeals of suspension for eleven (11) days or more shall remain as set forth in statute.

Any secondary student suspended by a site director or other proper administrator for ten (10) days or less shall have the right to appeal such suspension to a committee consisting of certified personnel appointed by the superintendent. The said committee shall conduct a full investigation of the matter, which shall determine the guilt or innocence of the pupil. If guilt is established, the committee shall then determine the reasonableness of the suspension. If innocence is established, the student shall be returned to the classroom from which he/she came and given opportunity to make up any work missed.

The decision of the committee shall be final.

The committee shall be appointed by the superintendent from certified personnel not connected with the original suspension. The committee shall meet as soon as possible commensurate with granting the student the right to representation and opportunity to present a case; but in any case, the hearing shall be held within three (3) working days of the suspension, at a time designated by the superintendent.
