1.0 POLICY:

A minor student may possess a wireless communication device at school with the prior written permission of a parent/guardian and the site director. The minor student must also sign an agreement with the site director that sets forth the limits or use of the device and gives notice of the penalties if the device is misused. An adult student may possess a wireless communication device at school with prior written agreement signed by the adult student and the site director.

Any agreement signed, as set forth above, shall require forfeiture of the right to use the wireless telecommunication device at school if such device is misused. Misuse shall be considered to be use of the device that disrupts school activities, whether intentional or not, or any criminal use of the device. Provided, the site director, for good cause shown by the student or parent, may excuse misuse and no penalty will be assessed. At all times, no penalty will be assessed without a hearing conducted informally by the site director to ascertain the true facts.
