The Board supports federal and state law that states believes that administering medication to students is not the responsibility of the District. District personnel shall not administer any type of medication to students.

The Superintendent shall ensure that procedures are in place to allow students to self-administer prescribed asthma and/or anaphylaxis medications, including but not limited to an epinephrine injector.
