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1.0 POLICY:

As permitted by law, each board member shall receive \$25.00 per each regular, special, emergency and/or committee meeting, not to exceed four (4) meetings per month. This payment is in the nature of per diem for expenses.

In addition, each board member shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred, not to exceed compensation in the sum of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per day and actual expenses which are itemized and documented for lodging, meals, registration fees and transportation to and from the place of the workshop, as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act, for attendance at the required New School Board Member Workshop, whether the person attending is a new board member, who must attend twelve (12) hours of instruction, or an incumbent member, who must attend six (6) hours of instruction, within fifteen (15) months of election.
