

BOARD POLICIES	METRO TECHNOLOGY CENTERS BOARD ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING (BP-2006)	The on-line version of the policy is official. Therefore, all printed versions are unofficial copies.
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1.0 POLICY:

At the first regular, special or emergency meeting following the annual school election and certification of new board members, the Board shall elect from its membership, by majority vote, a president and vice president, each of whom shall serve for a term of one year or until a successor is elected and qualified. The following procedure shall be used in the election of Board officers.

The superintendent shall:

- A. Chair the meeting for nomination and election of the president.
- B. Accept nominations from any board member.
- C. State three times, "Are there any more nominations" when he/she believes that nominations are complete.
- D. Close the nominations if there are no more nominations.

The clerk shall call the roll and board members will state which nominee they vote for. If a board member chooses to abstain he/shall will vote "present."

The clerk shall, at the conclusion of the roll call, repeat the result. A member will be elected to an office when he/she receives a majority of the votes cast.

The Board shall also elect a vice president, who is a member of the Board.

The Board shall also elect a clerk and a deputy clerk, either of who may be one of the members of the Board, to hold office during the pleasure of the Board and receive such compensation as the Board sets. Neither the clerk nor deputy clerk shall be superintendent, principal, campus director, or teacher of this District.

The Board may appoint a committee that shall present a slate of officers, and may elect the slate by acclamation.
