**1.0 POLICY:**

The superintendent shall appoint an advisory council to provide stakeholder input. The council will be composed of a cross-section of community representatives, including those from sending schools, local colleges, businesses and industries.

The council is advisory only to the superintendent and Board. The Council shall assist and advise concerning the District's efforts to meet students' and stakeholders' needs.

Copies of the minutes of meetings shall be distributed to council members.
