1.0 POLICY:

The Board believes it has the responsibility to keep the public informed on District needs, including school bond and millage elections. Therefore, when bond or millage elections arise, District funds may be used to provide informational material to the public concerning District bond elections and millage elections including, but not limited to, all pertinent financial information relative to the bond issue, statement on current bonded indebtedness of the technology center and a statement of proposed use of funds to be generated by proposed bond issue, and to encourage people to cast their votes. However, none of the informational material provided to the public shall advocate either support of or opposition to any bond or millage election.
