

BOARD POLICIES	METRO TECHNOLOGY CENTERS USE OF FIREARMS BY SECURITY OFFICERS (BP-5010)	The on-line version of the policy is official. Therefore, all printed versions are unofficial copies.
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1.0 POLICY:

The Board recognizes that the use of firearms by law enforcement officers is specifically authorized and limited by Oklahoma State Law. Security officers shall not deviate from the state law in the use of firearms, and in all circumstances shall bear in mind the value of human life and exercise the utmost discretion in the use of a weapon.

The following procedures will be used when a firearm is discharged (except on firearms range) by a security officer:

- A. The security officer will notify the immediate supervisor any time a firearm is discharged.
- B. The site director will relieve the officer involved from duty, pending the outcome of an investigation of the matter. The relief from duty shall not be construed as disciplinary action.
- C. The superintendent shall be notified immediately any time a firearm is discharged.
- D. The site director, associate/assistant superintendent and the security supervisor shall conduct an investigation.
- E. A copy of all reports concerning the incident shall be sent to the superintendent.
- F. The superintendent shall forward all reports of the incident to the Board with any recommendations as to action to be taken by the Board.
