1.0 POLICY:

All District facilities which have secondary students and/or daycare students and their environs shall be designated as non-smoking. Smoking shall be allowed in designated outside areas only, outside the facilities after 4:00 p.m., and on days when secondary school is not in session. The superintendent will ensure appropriate procedures to ensure this policy is enforced.
