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1.0 POLICY:

The use, possession or distribution of illegal drugs and other prohibited substances on school property, while engaged in or attending a school activity, or while going to or returning from school, is prohibited by school policy as well as the law and is cause for removal from school. For this purpose, illegal drugs and other prohibited substances include alcohol, nonalcoholic beer, intoxicants, marijuana, controlled substances, imitation controlled substances, and paraphernalia.

The Board authorizes the superintendent or designee to implement the regulations of the Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1988, Omnibus Transportation Employee Testing Act of 1991, and Oklahoma statutes for Workplace Drug and Alcohol Testing Act, Section 551 of Title 40, and other regulations as required in order to maintain a drug-free workplace for all employees.

The superintendent will develop procedures to ensure appropriate enforcement of this policy.
