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1.0 POLICY:

The Board supports a comprehensive guidance program to provide students with information on career options and to advise them on appropriate educational paths to meet their career goals and to provide students with the necessary support for success in their program.

- A. The counseling staff, parents, administrators, and others, shall provide guidance and counseling program direction through involvement in assessment and identification of student needs.
- B. The District shall provide an organized program of guidance and counseling services.
- C. If a technology education program at the Technology Center is considered to be an appropriate part of the student's IEP, a representative of the Technology Center shall be on the IEP team. The instructor of the technology program shall have access to a copy of the IEP before the student enters the technology program.
- D. Metro Tech staff shall work with sending schools to determine occupational needs, interests, and abilities of potential Technology Center students.
