**1.0 POLICY:**

The District will provide a diversified and balanced program of appropriate career and technical student organization (CTSO) activities, which are an integral part of each program curricula.

Each full-time program shall have an active and appropriate CTSO as an integral part of the program.

Each student who participates in a CTSO shall be involved in the CTSO designated for the occupational program in which the student is enrolled.

The maximum number of absences for activities, whether sponsored by sending schools, Metro Technology Centers, or outside agencies/organizations, which removes the student from the classroom, shall be ten (10) for any one (1) class period of each school year. Excluded from this number are state and national levels of school-sponsored contests. State and national contests are those for which a student must earn the right to compete.

Secondary students who participate in CTSO activities at Metro Technology Centers shall meet the eligibility rules of the sending school in which they are also enrolled.

The leadership development activities associated with the CTSO shall be directed and supervised by the appropriate teacher/instructor with support and guidance from administration.

The District shall provide resources needed to support career and technical student organization activities.

School sponsored activities held when school is not in session shall follow the same standards as those held during the regular school year.
